


Accessing TIMA data base for Panel management

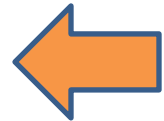
1. The TIMA database website address is: <http://tsinfdb/quality.php>
If you forget the link somehow the address is posted on the templeim.com website under outreach. You must use google chrome to access this site.

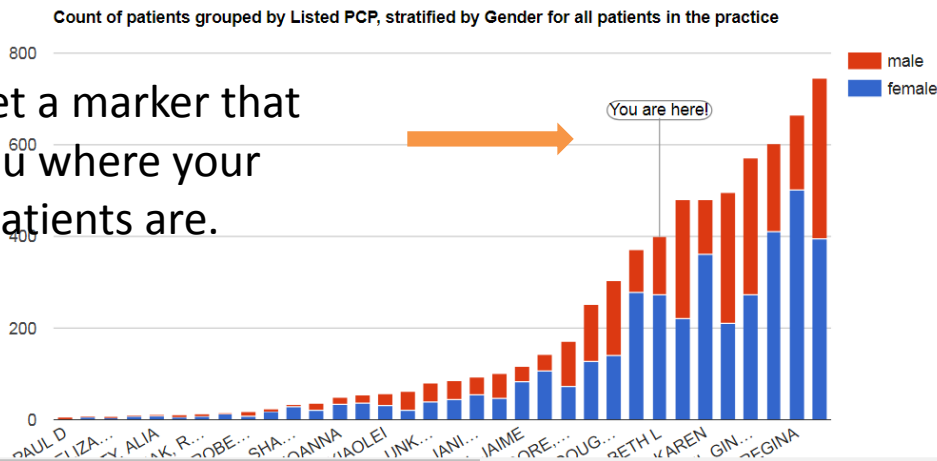
2. When you log on you will get a default graphical representation with all of the providers in the practice and the brake down of gender for their panel. You will see multiple columns at the top in which you can pick and choose the x and y axis to graphically display the data you are interested in.

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Variables you can stratify your data

You will get a marker that will tell you where your panel of patients are.



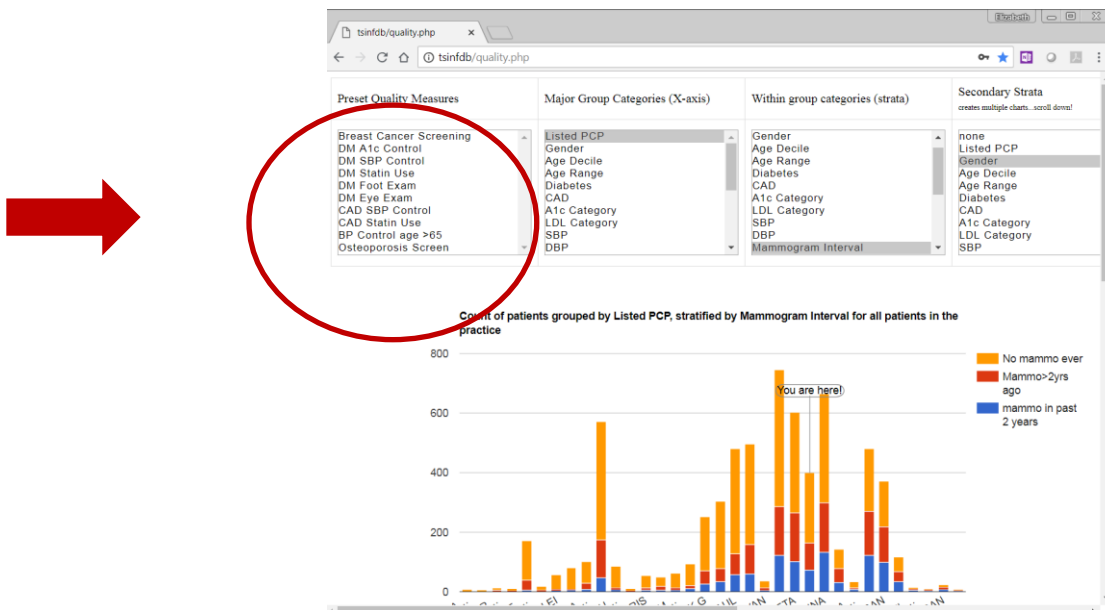
As a resident Make sure you have selected the Med Group tab to see yourself. If you are an attending or a primary care track resident you may have to select TIMA to view your data.

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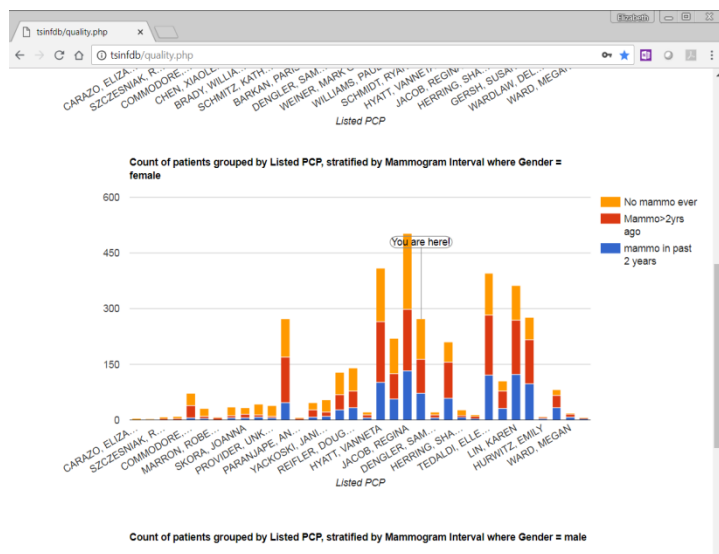
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- You have the option to play around with the x and y variables to learn more about the demographics of your patient panel however, if that is too complicated for you we have already preset the TUP institutional Quality indicators for you and with the click of one of the buttons in the Left hand column you will be able to see how your panel of patients are performing.



This is where you are going to want to go to find out how you are doing for each assigned quality indicator for the ambulatory week. Take for instance, the outreach topic of the week is mammogram which is currently selected on the screen. You might notice I have a lot of patients who have no mammograms ever. Well that is because the data currently includes both females and males. Scroll down to see the other graphs with stratify the data by gender.

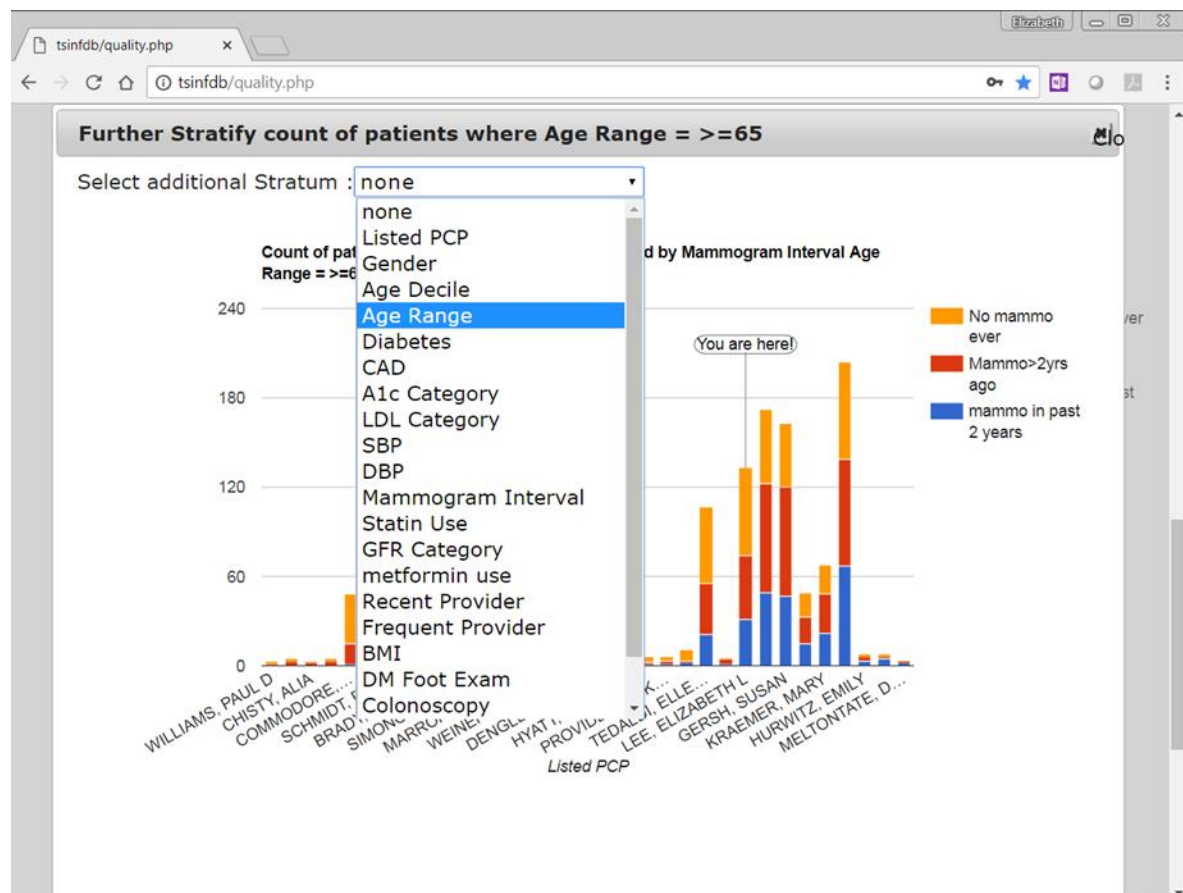


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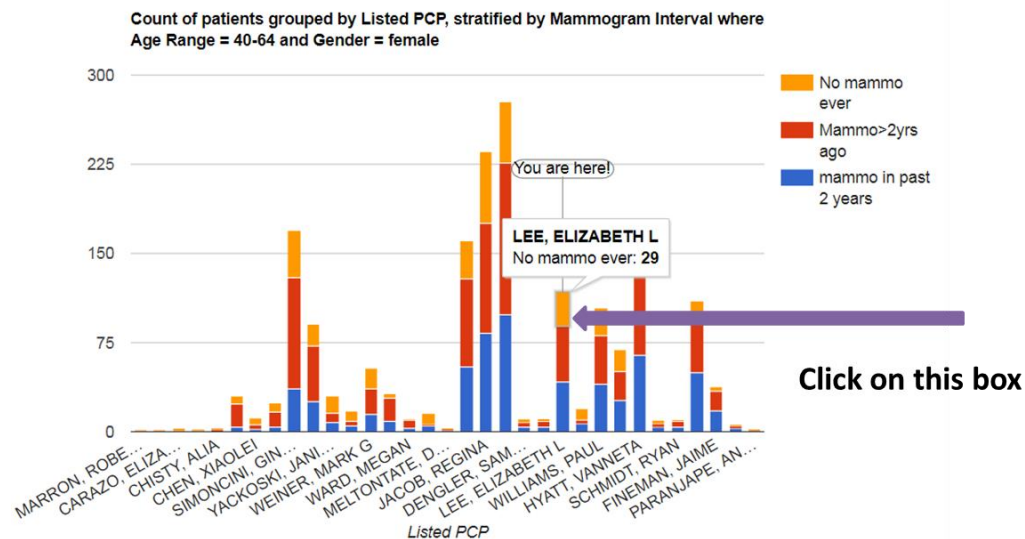
4. The next step is to further stratify the data by age because women of only a certain age group are eligible for mammograms. If you hold down the **control button and left click** on the graph wait a few seconds and you will get a box that will allow you to further stratify the data. In this case of mammogram, I would like to see the data stratified further by age.



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You will get a screen that will look like this and display the MRN and names of your patients whom are overdue for preventative services.
